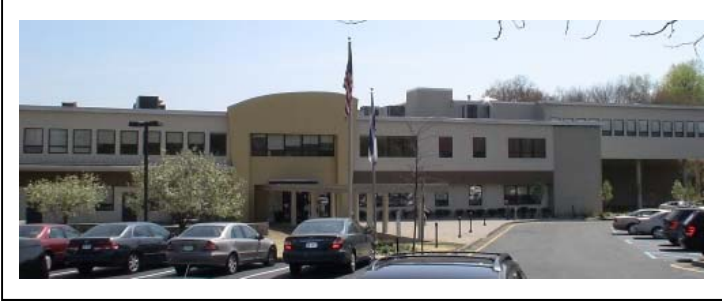


Exciting News!

Maher and Kelly Pereira attended the Women's Leadership Conference where Lee Woodruff, Bob's wife, spoke of her experiences in the aftermath of the accident.
